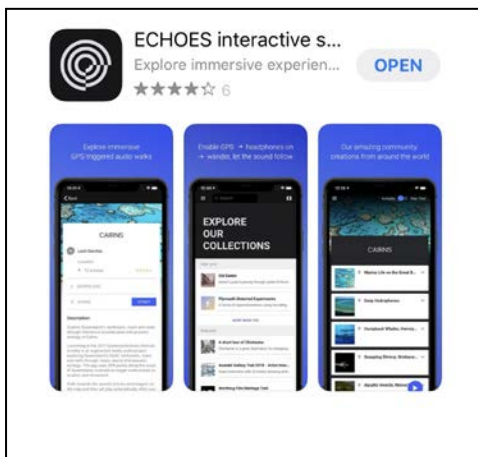


How To Access the Londinium Poetry Walk

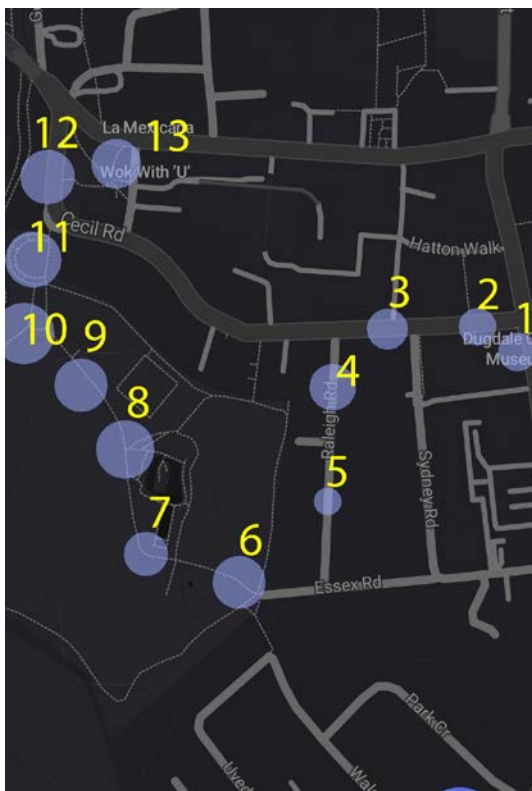
Welcome to the Londinium Poetry walk an exciting event created by the artist/poet Giovanna Iorio. By following the Echoes route (see below) you will hear a selection of the 39 translations of my poem “Londinium” a project I conceived to celebrate difference and the 300 languages spoken in London.

To follow the walk, you first have to download the app onto your Smartphone. Go to the shop for apps and search “Echoes”. It is suitable for both IOS and Android phones.



Once downloaded look for nearby walks and you will see the Londinium Poetry Walk. Click on it and you will see the map. The audio files play when you walk into the Blue Bubble the first of which is outside the Dugdale revolving doors.

The walk then takes you to Cecil road. Left down Raleigh road and through the Town Park to Library Green. Do not forget to stop the walk. This can be done by clicking on the three horizontal bar icon top left of the Echoes screen.
